Our environmental policy seeks to minimize and mitigate risks generated by the operation of the company, and generate value and opportunity for all. Our environmental management team highlights as actions that are based on the principles of sustainability:

- 5.1. The dissemination and implementation of the company's environmental policy for all employees, service providers, suppliers and the general public;
- 5.2. Reducing the consumption of natural resources, seeking to conserve the environment;
- 5.3. Reducing waste generation and promoting proper management of generated waste;
- 5.4. From the circular economy, efficiently manage natural resources, keeping products, components and materials at their highest level of utility;
- 5.5. Monitoring the unit's environmental performance through specific indicators;
- 5.6. The minimization of environmental impacts related to the operation of the manufacturing units, taking into account ESG management practices, demonstrating how the company is committed to having a more sustainable operation in environmental, social and governance terms. In this aspect, global warming and carbon emissions are taken into account; air and water pollution; biodiversity; deforestation and conversion of native vegetation; energy efficiency; Waste Management; water scarcity, customer satisfaction; data protection and privacy; team diversity; employee engagement; relationship with the community; respect for human rights and labor laws, composition of the Board; corporate conduct; relationship with government entities and politicians, and the existence of a whistleblower channel;
- 5.7. The implementation of a supply chain free from deforestation and illegal conversion of native vegetation, through the traceability of beef and soy embedded in chicken, fish and swine feed, carrying out risk analyzes and engaging suppliers for the implementation of purchasing control mechanisms. Patense considers 2008 as a cut-off date and is committed to implementing a supply chain free of deforestation and illegal conversion of native vegetation by 2040, in accordance with the goals established in the implementation plan.;
- 5.8. Conducting periodic audits seeking to monitor environmental performance;
- 5.9. The qualification and training of employees to minimize the risk of accidents at work, occupational problems and environmental incidents;
- 5.10. The development of actions and activities in accordance with environmental legislation, obtaining the certificates, records and licenses necessary for the operation of the enterprise;
- 5.11. The contracting of suppliers and service providers that comply with the legal provisions established for each area of activity;
- 5.12. The constant search for modern and efficient technologies to preserve the environment and improve the production process;
- 5.13. The promotion of education and awareness programs for issues related to the preservation of the environment and sustainability;
- 5.14. Fulfill the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) related to the items: Clean and affordable energy, Decent work and economic growth, Industry, innovation and infrastructure; Responsible consumption and production and Partnerships and means of implementation;
